



Contribution Eligibility Guidelines

SCE&G supports qualified nonprofit organizations within its electric and gas service territory. Grants are approved based on the recommendation of the Company's Contributions Committee, which meets regularly. Awards are made throughout the calendar year.

Qualified organizations are required to meet minimum requirements. Preference is given to support for programming that addresses a specific community need within our focus areas:

- Arts/Culture
- Community/Civic
- Education
- Environment
- Health

To complete an online application, you must meet these minimum requirements:

- Organizations must have a 501(c)3 or (c)6 designation from the Internal Revenue Service.
- All requests must be submitted in writing, preferably via our online application process. No telephone solicitations of any kind are considered.
- Contributions requests from agencies who receive grants from the United Way are not typically considered unless the request is for a capital project or significant program expansion.
- Funding of bond referendums is prohibited.
- The Company does not contribute to the travel funds of individuals or groups.
- The Company does not sponsor baseball, softball, swimming or other athletic teams.
- The Company does not make contributions through second parties (i.e. to professional fund raisers or any party who passes them to another charity).
- Donation of electric or gas service is prohibited by law.
- The Company does not contribute to social organizations, to include sororities and fraternities.
- Although we will support faith-based initiatives, the Company does not contribute to individual churches or religious groups.
- The Company supports K-12 schools through its Employee Matching Gifts program and homework center sponsorships. Therefore, we do not accept contribution requests from K-12 schools.
