SCE&G's Home Performance with ENERGY STAR Program helps you save money now and in the future with rebates of up to \$2,500 on energy-saving home improvements that are right for your home.

Home Performance with ENERGY STAR is an effective way to significantly reduce home energy consumption while improving indoor comfort. Rather than focusing on a single problem, like an old heating or cooling system, not enough insulation, or leaky windows, Home Performance with ENERGY STAR looks at how improvements throughout your home can work together to give you the best results.

Comprehensive Approach

The program, in partnership with the national Home Performance with ENERGY STAR program from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the U.S. Department of Energy, is a comprehensive approach to home energy-saving solutions. Beginning with a comprehensive home energy audit, participating contractors help homeowners identify and install the energy-saving home improvements and solutions that best fit their home and budget.

Rebates and Program Benefits

Lowering your utility bills is only part of the savings you'll see! Homeowners who make energy-efficient improvements through Home Performance with ENERGY STAR can save even more with SCE&G rebates up to \$2,500 for eligible improvements. The program provides rebates for four categories of improvements (see categories under Program Rebates). A customer can also earn a bonus incentive of \$400 for completing a Comfort Home Package which includes at least one measure from three categories of improvements.

By participating, you'll also enjoy additional benefits:

- Potential home energy savings of 20%–35%
- Fewer drafts and improved comfort
- Work performed by specially trained contractors
- Third-party quality assurance to check that all work is completed properly



Typical Home Improvement Recommendations

The Home Performance with ENERGY STAR program is designed to identify energy-saving solutions specific to your home. The following are examples of the most common home energy improvements identified to increase comfort and savings:

- Sealing air leaks and adding insulation
- Upgrading or replacing heating and cooling systems
- Sealing and insulating ductwork
- Fixing combustion equipment, such as furnaces and hot water heaters
- Replacing water heating systems

Who's Eligible?

To participate in the program, the applicant must be the registered owner of a separately metered, detached, or attached single-family residence where the product/equipment is installed. Rebate payments will only be made to the SCE&G electric account holder of record. Products/equipment must be installed in the SCE&G territory.

You must receive a home energy audit and install qualified measures and/or equipment through a participating Home Performance with ENERGY STAR Program contractor. Your contractor must be a program participant, and will be responsible for submitting the necessary rebate documentation on your behalf within 30 days of installation. Please allow 6–8 weeks from the date your application is approved to receive your rebate check. This is a one-time offer and cannot be renewed. See Terms and Conditions on the contract for further details.
