



## NOTICE

Trees, bushes and vegetation growing below the 360 foot contour on the shoreline of Lake Murray play an important role in the overall environmental condition of the Lake. The ecological impact the vegetation has on the fish and wildlife habitat is necessary to ensure a sound, healthy Lake environment.

South Carolina Electric & Gas Company's Shoreline Management Plan permits limited removal of the shoreline vegetation for the construction and installation of docks. Please be advised that unauthorized removal of shoreline vegetation (button bushes, willow trees, hardwood, etc.) will result in the cancellation of the dock permit and revegetation of the shoreline will be required.

Property owners must contact SCE&G's Lake Management Department prior to any removal of shoreline vegetation below the 360 contour.
