

Electric Rates Change

Energy Saver/Conservation Rate 6 is designed to reward residential customers who build or upgrade their homes to high efficiency standards, as prescribed by the Council of American Building Officials Model Energy Code. These standards are subject to change and affect ceilings, lighting, walls, floors, windows, doors, ducts, attic vents, water heaters, air conditioning, chimneys, and fireplaces.

Air conditioning standards may also be impacted by federal or state mandated energy codes. The most recent update for this requirement affects all homes permitted on or after January 23, 2006, which results in a current SEER rating of 14 or higher to qualify for service under Rate 6. This rating is subject to change as energy codes are updated or revised.

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The Public Service Commission of South Carolina (“PSC”) has approved changes to SCE&G retail electric rates. The net effect of these changes will vary depending upon each customer’s class of service and usage characteristics. The changes were pursuant to: 1) an increase in the Adjustment for Fuel, Variable Environmental, & Avoided Capacity Costs Component; 2) an increase in the Renewable Energy Resources charge; and 3) a decrease to the Demand Side Management Component (except for an increase to this Component for the small general service customer class). These changes will become effective for bills rendered on and after the first billing cycle of May 2018.

The Renewable Energy Resources charge, implemented in 2016 to recover costs and incentives associated with the implementation of Renewable Energy Resources in South Carolina, cannot exceed \$1 per month for residential customers, \$10 per month for commercial customers, and \$100 per month for industrial customers, in compliance with the Distributed Energy Resources Program Act of 2014.

The approved Rate 6 and Rate 8 for residential service is provided. Rates for other classes of customers may be obtained by contacting your local SCE&G office or by visiting sceg.com.
